Food Safety While Hiking or Camping

Sometimes you just have to get out of the house and walk around outside. It is hard to stay inside on a beautiful sunny day. You may want to hike for a few hours, or want to camp for a few days. You wouldn't have to pack a lot of food for a short hike. If you were going camping, you would need more food.

The main rule is to keep hot foods hot and cold foods cold. To keep food cold, you can freeze juice boxes. The juice boxes will thaw during the day and keep your food cold at the same time.

You should always take water with you to drink because the water from lakes and rivers may look clean but in fact is not that safe. Always start with a full bottle of water. Carry more with you if you have room.

What foods should you bring while camping? Cold foods will only be good the first day. After that you will have to take some canned foods. Dried pasta is another food that is easy to cook. Carry things like this in a plastic bag. Take only as much as you will need.

You also have to think about how you will heat the food. If you are bringing a stove, remember to put everything together. You don't want to be out in the forest and find that you forget something.

The last thing you should keep in mind is that you don't leave anything behind. Take everything back home, even the trash!
