Item 3 – a robot box, once kids finish their “code”, they can see the box move.

Item 4 – a giant map, several kinds of places such as forests, cities, or deserts!

How to code –

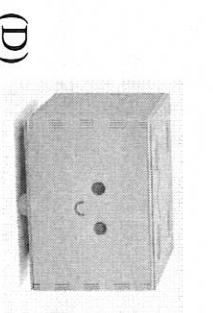
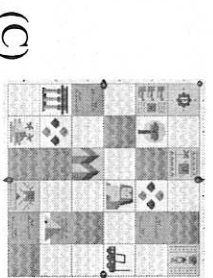
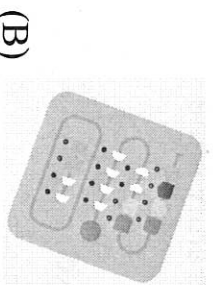
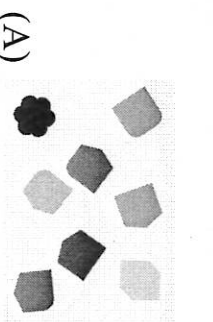
Step 1 – Find the destination you want to go.

The Swiss army knife is a popular device all over the world. In Switzerland, there is a saying that every good Swiss citizen has one in his or her pocket. Do you know how the knife became popular?

In the late 19th century, the Swiss army thought its soldiers needed a special screwdriver to dismantle and clean their guns. At the same time, canned food was becoming common in the army. Swiss generals decided to give each soldier a standard knife to serve both as a screwdriver and a can opener.

It was a lifesaver for Swiss knife makers because they were competing with cheaper German knives. In 1884, Carl Elsener, designed a soldier's knife that the army loved. It was a simple knife with one big blade, a can opener, and a screwdriver. Carl sold more knives than the original manufacturer, Victorinox.

A few years later, the soldier's knife was called "Schweizer Offizier Messer" or Swiss Officer's Knife, and it came on the market. Interestingly, the soldiers in the army didn't have the chance to use the Officer's Knife at first. The Swiss buyers thought the new knife with a corkscrew for opening wine was not essential for survival. Some officers had to buy this knife by themselves. But its special design really made the knife become a global brand.

After the Second World War, a great number of American soldiers came to Europe. They bought a lot of Swiss army knife there. However, it seems that "Schweizer Offizier Messer" was too difficult for them to say, so they just called it the Swiss army knife. That is the name it is known by all over the world.
