When people are unhappy or treated badly at work, what do they do? They usually look for a new job and then leave. But sometimes, it is hard to give up a job. Why? Some people don't want to tell their bosses they are leaving. Their bosses might speak to them in a mean way, or even harass them. For example, a boss might shout at a worker every day, or say mean things to them to make them feel bad. Some workers are afraid their bosses will get angry. Others think their bosses won't let them leave.

In Japan, some workers are using a new way to leave their jobs. They ask an agency to help them. The agency tells the boss that the worker is leaving. The worker does not need to go back to the company. These agencies are busy! One agency in Tokyo has helped 20,000 workers leave their jobs. First, the worker answers some questions. Then, they pay the agency. It costs about \$4,700 NT for a full-time worker and \$2,600 NT for a part-time worker. After that, the agency calls the company. It only takes 30 minutes to leave the worker's job! In Japan, workers must work very hard. They work long hours and usually stay at one company for a long time. Companies think giving up a job is bad because it costs money to find new workers. But many workers feel unhappy and don't want to work all the time. These agencies are a big help for them!

Best Ways to Sleep for Better Health

Sleeping is very important for our health. How you sleep can make a big difference. Here are the main sleeping positions and what they do for your body:

Sleeping on Your Side

Most people sleep on their side. It is good for your back and neck and can help with snoring. Sleeping on your left side is also good for your stomach. But sometimes, your shoulders might feel uncomfortable.

Sleeping in the Fetal Position

This is like sleeping on your side with your legs curled up. It can help with snoring and is good for blood flow. But it may not help your back or joints.

Sleeping on Your Back

Lying on your back can help with neck and back pain. But this position can make snoring worse.


Sleeping on Your Stomach

Only a few people sleep on their stomachs. You lie on your tummy with your head to the side. This can stop snoring, but it is bad for your neck and back. It can also make you feel tired when you wake up.

Tips for Better Sleep

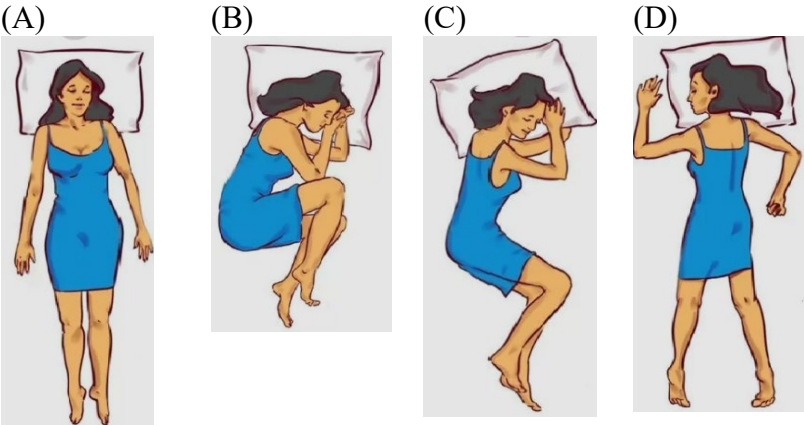
1. Try different positions to see what works for you.
2. Change slowly if your position is not comfortable.
3. Use a pillow to support your body.
