

"Women cannot be sushi chefs because of their period." These words came from the mouth of Yoshikazu Ono, the owner of the famous sushi restaurant. The chef explained that women are not able to make sushi well at all times because their hands are warmer and their taste and smell change with their period. Although the reason sounds stupid, it is actually widely believed by many Japanese people. They still think women should stay home to take care of their family, and that is why we seldom see women chefs working at sushi restaurants in Japan.

However, things have been changing, though very slowly. These years, women can finally go to sushi schools, and some sushi restaurants begin to hire women chefs. Of all those people fighting for women's rights to work as sushi chefs, Nadeshiko Sushi is probably the most famous. The boss and all of the sushi restaurant workers are women. There they often meet diners with <u>stereotypes</u>. For example, a man wanted to try sushi first for his boss to make sure it was "safe to eat"; another man asked for another chef because the chef "looked too fat"; some don't think the chef look professional because they aren't dressed in white. Though stereotypes hurt, these women keep fighting because they love the job and are proud of it, and more and more diners tell them that their sushi is great.
